Zion Lutheran School's 2018-2019 school year came to an end this year on May 31<sup>st</sup> with closing chapel. A slide presentation of events that happened over the past school year was shown to the students and the parents that joined us for this last day.

To measure how our students perform academically we take the MAP Tests (Measure of Academic Progress) given through NWEA (Northwest Evaluation Association). These tests are taken in 49 foreign countries, 50 states, and 3400 districts. During the Spring Testing held in April our students that scored in the High to Average range were: 81% in Reading, 72% in Math, and 89% in Language.

Our eighth grade class graduated on Tuesday – May 28<sup>th</sup> at our Graduation and Awards Night Celebration. This year's class included: Samantha Gerdes, Morgan Harrison, Kendra Klimek, Audrey Kuhnau, Marly Nolz, and Charlie Mistele. We wish them God's Blessings as they move on to high school.

Also moving on this year to different paths in their lives are: Karrie Anderson – our Pre-Kindergarten teacher; Becky Mistele – who has been one of our Kindergarten aides for several years; Lynette Swedberg – our part-time middle school aide; and Jaci Loween – our part-time middle school teacher. We thank them for their service to Zion Lutheran School and wish them well.

Other activities take place in the school during the summer time. Wendy Simonson and Barb Chan, along with various helpers, run our summer breakfast and lunch program. They begin this program a week after school ends, on June 10<sup>th</sup>. Vacation Bible School is the week of June 10<sup>th</sup>. Many, various camps run throughout the summer months. In between everything that takes place in the building, our custodian – Cindy Hemsworth, is busy doing a thorough cleaning job of the building – getting it ready for the next school year.

Zion Lutheran School would like to give a big "Thank You" to the members of Zion Lutheran Church who are so generous with their support of the School. Thanks for the prayers, the monetary gifts, the use of SCRIP, the volunteers that help, and more. An extra special "Thank You" goes to the Church Property Board who is always there when we need them. 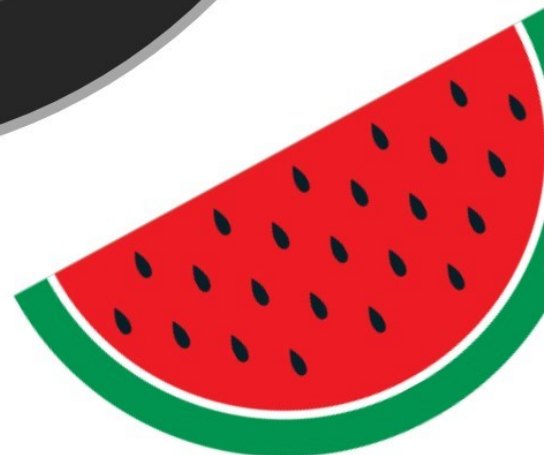

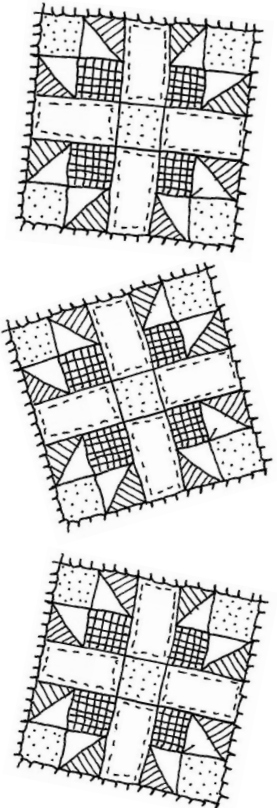

Lutheran World Relief operates in East and West Africa, Latin America, Asia and the Middle East, helping some of the world's poorest communities build the resilience they need to thrive.

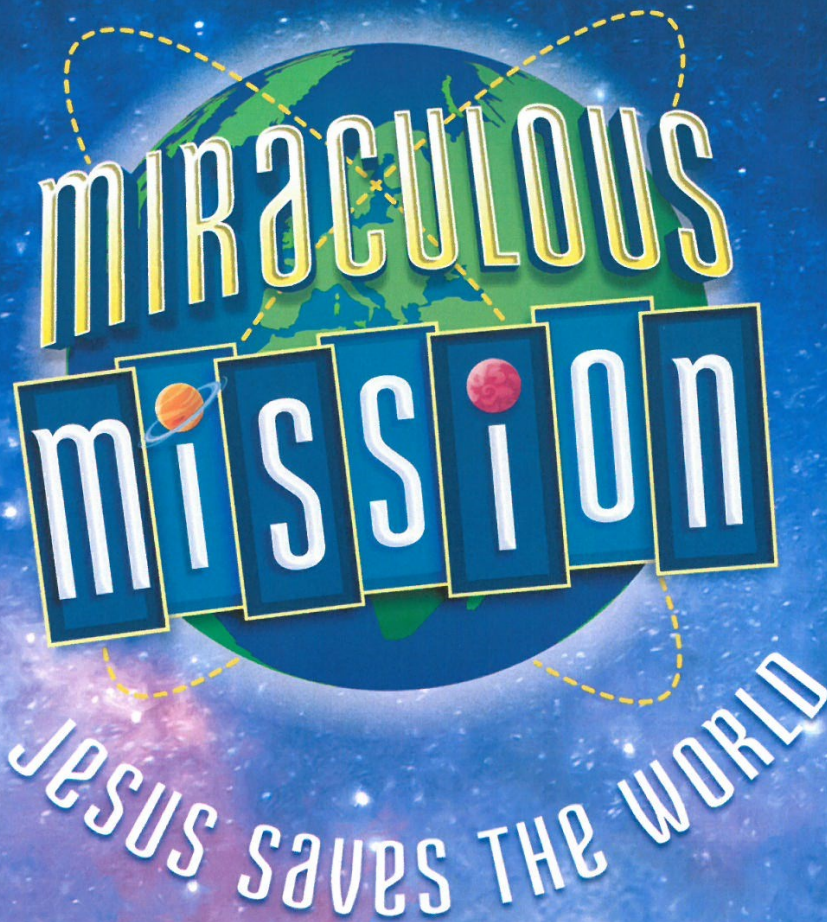
